- Robust and reliable data essential for assessing effectiveness and impact of ESF.
- Data Collection Summary Action Plan – completed/submitted to the Commission with the draft ESF OP (PEIL 2014-2020).
- Potential for financial penalties; suspension/non-payment of claims
- Audit
